WHAT IS THE CHARITIES EDUCATION PROGRAM (CEP)?

The Canada Revenue Agency is committed to giving registered charities the educational tools and resources they need to easily fulfill their regulatory obligations.

CEP is designed to provide charities with in-person support.



INFORMATION SHARING

The officer will provide information, support and in-person guidance to help the charity meet its regulatory obligations. The officer will also address questions the charity may have.

HOW LONG WILL THE VISIT TAKE?

The visit will take approximately one-half to a full day.

IS CEP AN AUDIT?

No. A CEP visit is not an audit. The purpose of a CEP visit is to provide support and information.
