


## Determinants of HIV and Hepatitis C among people who inject drugs in Canada, 2017–2019

The Tracks survey of people who inject drugs was conducted between January 2017 and May 2019 in 14 sentinel sites in Canada. People who had injected drugs (PWID) in the 6 months prior to the recruitment were invited to complete an interviewer-administered questionnaire and asked to provide a biological sample that was tested for HIV antibodies and hepatitis C antibodies and RNA.
