

The **ATLANTIC IMMIGRATION PILOT** made a permanent program in 2021

GROWING INNOVATIVE BUSINESSES

123 firms received customized support

As of 2019, there were **410** high-growth firms in the region, 1.2 times the baseline of 340 set in 2014

In 2019, **33.4%** of Atlantic businesses used advanced technology, compared to 14.7% in 2012
