### Compassionate Care Benefits Attestation

A new regulatory provision expands the list of family members which includes a person who is considered a close relative or **"like a family member"**, by the patient.

The claimant must submit this attestation signed by the gravely ill family member or a representative, to be considered a close family member, or **like a family member** of the patient.

Failure to complete this form will result in not being entitled to receive compassionate care benefits.
