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Farm product prices

June 2008

Prices received by farmers in June for grains, oilseeds, specialty crops, potatoes, cattle, hogs, poultry, eggs and dairy products are now available.

The Quebec oats price in June was \$216.00 per metric tonne, up 7% from May and up 30% from June 2007 when the price was \$165.98.

The June feeder cattle price in Manitoba was \$90.46 per hundredweight, up 5% from May but down 8% from the June 2007 price of \$97.75.

Farm commodity prices are now available on CANSIM. Prices for over 35 commodities are available by province, some series going back 20 years.

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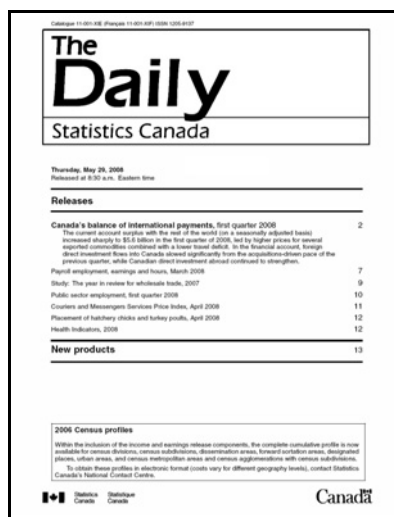
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
