Oilseed processors crushed 361 669 metric tonnes of canola in September. Oil production in September totalled 154 031 tonnes while meal production amounted to 212 356 tonnes.

Sawmills

August 2008

Monthly lumber production by sawmills decreased 10.1% to 4 223.2 thousand cubic metres in August.

Sawmills shipped 4 402.6 thousand cubic metres of lumber in August, down 13.2% from July.

Lumber shipments were down 25.5% in August compared with the same month a year earlier.
