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Airport activity

2007 (preliminary)

Air passenger traffic at Canadian airports increased 4.4% in 2007, while the total number of enplaned/deplaned passengers stood at 106.1 million. Passenger traffic has shown an increasing trend since 2003.

All sectors (domestic, transborder, and other international) experienced growth in passenger traffic in 2007, with the other international sector (+6.0%) posting the largest increase.

In 2007, 10 of the 13 provinces and territories experienced growth in domestic passenger traffic.

Three provinces accounted for 72.6% of all domestic passenger traffic: Ontario (28.7%), British Columbia (22.2%), and Alberta (21.7%).

Cargo tonnages loaded and unloaded at Canadian airports increased by 12.9% in 2007.

Canadian ports handled 466.3 million metric tonnes of cargo in 2006, down 1.1% from 2005. Both international and domestic sectors were responsible for the decrease.

Canada's balance of international payments, first quarter 2008	2
The largest export supplier with the rest of the world (on a seasonally adjusted basis) increased sharply to \$5.5 billion in the first quarter of 2008, led by higher prices for several exported commodities combined with a larger export deficit in the financial account. Foreign direct investment flows into Canada slowed significantly from the acquisition-driven pace of the previous quarter, while Canadian direct investment abroad continued to strengthen.
