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Farm product prices

February 2009

Prices received by farmers in February for grains, oilseeds, specialty crops, potatoes, cattle, hogs, poultry, eggs and dairy products are now available.

The February Quebec hogs price was \$61.32 per hundredweight, up 8.4% from January, and up 38.4% from February 2008 when the price was \$44.30.

The Manitoba oat price in February was \$164.56 per metric tonne, down 10.6% from January. The oat price in Manitoba was down 14.6% from February 2008 when it stood at \$192.74.

The Saskatchewan oat price in February was \$140.01 per metric tonne, down 17.0% from January. The oat price in Saskatchewan was down 18.5% from February 2008 when it stood at \$171.84.

Farm commodity prices are now available on CANSIM. Prices for over 35 commodities are available by province, some series going back 20 years.

Aircraft movement statistics: Small airports

January 2009

The number of take-offs and landings at the 118 airports without air traffic control towers reached 31,649 movements in January, down 9.4% compared with the 34,928 take-offs and landings for the 120 airports reported in January 2008.

Goose Bay, Newfoundland and Labrador, was the most active site in January 2009, recording 1,823 movements.

Canada's balance of international payments, first quarter 2008 2
The current account surplus with the rest of the world (on a seasonally adjusted basis) increased sharply to \$5.3 billion in the first quarter of 2008, led by higher prices for mineral exports. Exports continued with a lower trade deficit. In the financial account, foreign direct investment flows into Canada showed significantly from the expenditure-driven price of the previous quarter, while Canada's direct investment abroad continued to strengthen.
