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Farm product prices

September 2009

Prices received by farmers in September for grains, oilseeds, specialty crops, potatoes, cattle, hogs, poultry, eggs and dairy products are now available.

The Saskatchewan non-board wheat price in September was \$140.41 per metric tonne, down 17% from August and down 24% from September 2008 when the price was \$184.37.

The September hog price for Quebec was \$50.02 per hundredweight, up 1% from August but down 27% from September 2008 when the price was \$68.93.

Note: Farm commodity prices are now available on CANSIM. Prices for over 35 commodities are available by province, some series going back 20 years.

Aircraft movement statistics: Small airports

August 2009

The number of take-offs and landings at the 119 airports without air traffic control towers reached 62,794 movements in August, down 8.6% compared with the 68,698 take-offs and landings for the 120 airports reported in August 2008.

Guelph, Ontario (3,002 movements), followed by Barrie-Orillia-Lake Simcoe Regional, Ontario (2,463 movements), were the most active sites in August 2009.

Consulting Engineering Services Price Index

2007 (preliminary)

The Consulting Engineering Services Price Index (CESPI) is now available for 2007. The Canada total CESPI for 2007 was 133.7 (1997=100), up 4.5% from the revised 2006 index of 127.9.

Note: The Consulting Engineering Services Price Index measures the change in the total price of engineering and consulting services, as well as changes in the wage rate and realized net multiplier components. Detailed indexes are available for fields of specialization and for regional, domestic and foreign markets.
