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Crude oil and natural gas: Supply and disposition

January 2010 (preliminary)

Domestic production of crude oil and equivalent hydrocarbons totalled 12.9 million cubic metres in January, down 4.6% from January 2009.

Crude oil and equivalent exports were down 1.6% in January compared with the same month in 2009.

Definitions, data sources and methods: survey number 2198.

Note: Preliminary natural gas data for January 2010 are not available at this time pending further analysis. Preliminary data for crude oil (126-0001) are available on CANSIM at the national level to January 2010 inclusive. At the national and provincial level, detailed information is available for crude oil up to October 2009 inclusive, and for natural gas (131-0001) up to March 2009 inclusive.

Sawmills

January 2010

Monthly lumber production by sawmills increased 18.8% to 4 082.7 thousand cubic metres in January. Compared with January 2009, lumber production increased 2.0%.

Sawmills shipped 4 116.4 thousand cubic metres of lumber in January, up 12.5% from December.

Production and disposition of tobacco products

February 2010

Canadian manufacturers produced 1.8 billion cigarettes in February, up 4.3% from January. The total number of cigarettes sold decreased by 13.7% to 1.5 billion and closing inventories increased by 19.7% to 2.2 billion cigarettes in February.

Note: This survey collects data on the production of tobacco products in Canada by Canadian manufacturers and the disposition or sales of this production. It does not collect data on imported tobacco products. Therefore, sales information in this release is not a proxy for domestic consumption of tobacco products.
