Revised data for 1990 to 2005 and preliminary data for 2006 from the Material and Energy Flow Accounts on energy use and greenhouse gas emissions by industries, governments and households are now available. 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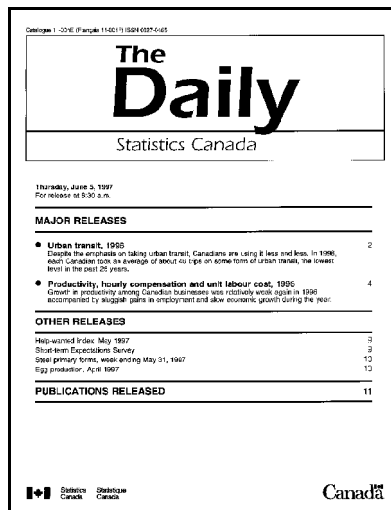
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
