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Crude oil and natural gas: Supply and disposition

February 2010 (preliminary)

Domestic production of crude oil and equivalent hydrocarbons totalled 12.5 million cubic metres in February, down 0.9% from February 2009.

Crude oil and equivalent exports were up 3.0% compared with the same month in 2009.

Definitions, data sources and methods: survey number 2198.

Note: Preliminary natural gas data for February 2010 are not available at this time pending further analysis. Preliminary data for crude oil (126-0001) are available on CANSIM at the national level to February 2010 inclusive. At the national and provincial level, detailed information is available for crude oil up to December 2009 inclusive, and for natural gas (131-0001) up to March 2009 inclusive.

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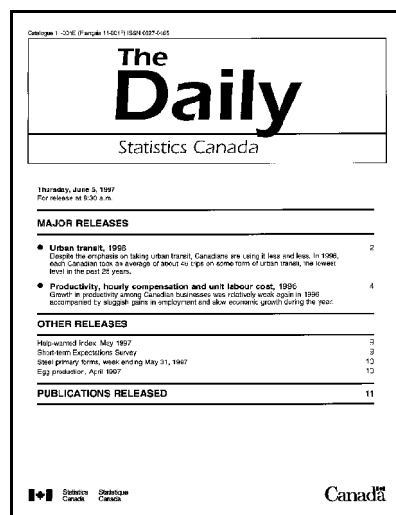
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
