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Aircraft movement statistics: Small airports

February 2010

The number of take-offs and landings at the 134 airports without air traffic control towers reached 37,660 movements in February. Year-over-year increases were reported by 66 of these airports. Comox, British Columbia (2,080 movements), followed by Goose Bay, Newfoundland and Labrador (1,701 movements), were the most active sites in February.
