Crude oil and natural gas: Supply and disposition

April 2010 (preliminary)

Domestic production of crude oil and equivalent hydrocarbons totalled 13.4 million cubic metres in April, up 7.7% from April 2009.

Crude oil and equivalent exports were up 6.7% in April compared with the same month in 2009. About 68% of Canada's domestic production went to the export market.

Marketable natural gas production totalled 11.1 billion cubic metres in April, down 6.2% compared with the same month a year earlier, while domestic sales of natural gas increased by 2.7%.

Natural gas exports fell by 4.8% in April from the same month a year earlier. Exports accounted for about 64% of marketable natural gas production.

Note: Preliminary data are available on CANSIM at the national level to April 2010 inclusive. At the national and provincial level detailed information is available for crude oil (126-0001) up to February 2010 inclusive, and for natural gas (131-0001) up to December 2009 inclusive.

Despite the emphasis on taking urban transit, Canadians are using it less and less. In 1996, each Canadian took an average of about 40 trips on some form of urban transit, the lowest level in the past 25 years.
