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Farm product prices

August 2010

Prices received by farmers in August for grains, oilseeds, specialty crops, potatoes, cattle, hogs, poultry, eggs and dairy products are now available.

The August Quebec grain corn price was \$158.00 per metric tonne, down 2% from July and down 12% from August 2009 when the price was \$179.69.

The August feeder cattle price for Alberta was \$85.02 per hundredweight, up 10% from July and up 12% from August 2009 when the price was \$75.62.

Farm commodity prices are now available on CANSIM. Prices for over 35 commodities are available by province, some series going back 20 years.
