

The cannabis excise stamp



Does your cannabis product require a cannabis excise stamp?

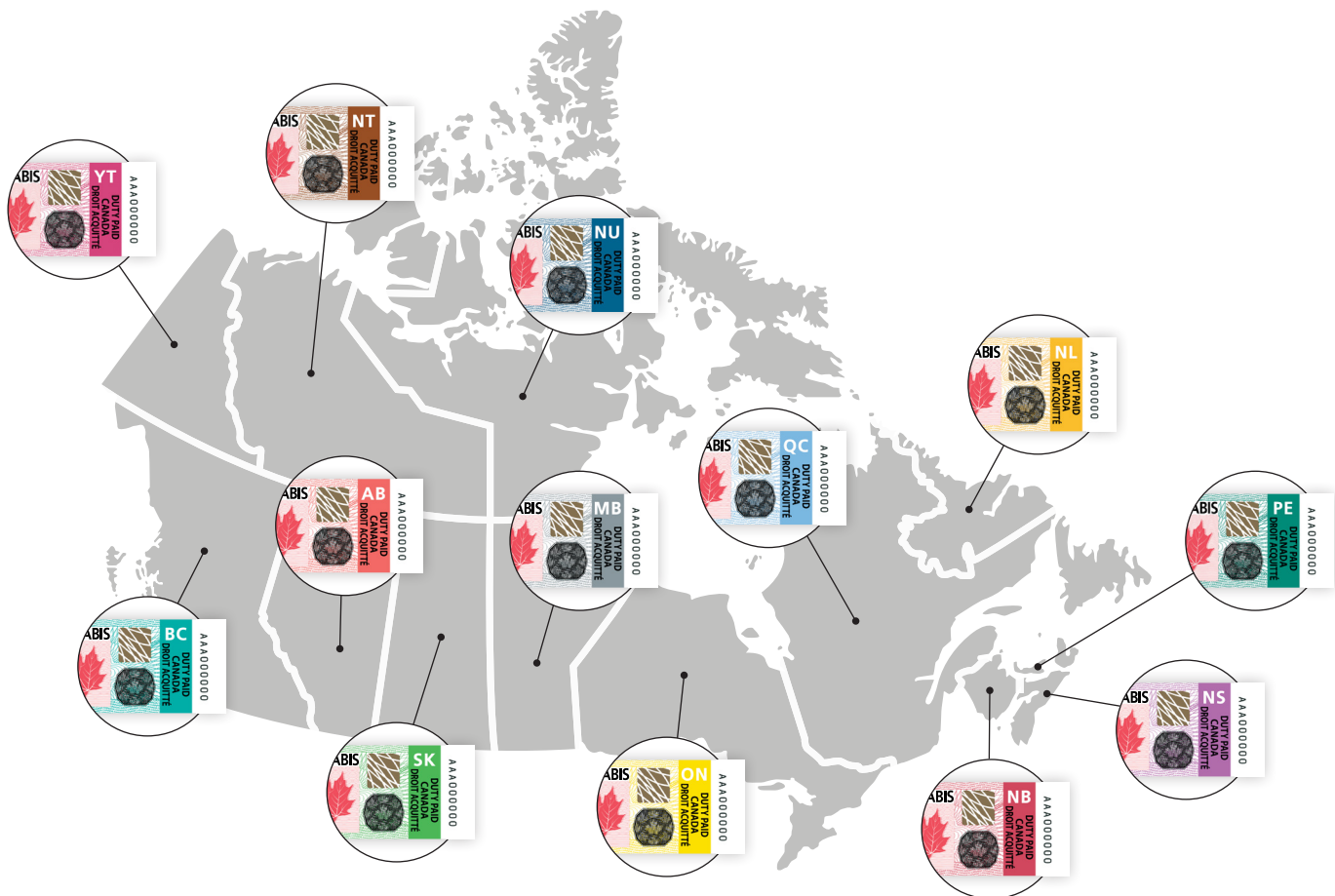
With a few exceptions, a cannabis excise stamp must be present on all packaged cannabis products that have been legally produced and are available for purchase.

This includes:

- ▶ Packaged cannabis products delivered to purchasers for medical purposes;
- ▶ Packaged cannabis products delivered to a purchaser for adult use purposes;
- ▶ Packaged cannabis product delivered to another cannabis licensee; and
- ▶ All edible cannabis and cannabis topicals and any cannabis extracts that do not meet the definition of low-THC for purposes of the excise duty framework on cannabis.

Which stamp should be applied to the cannabis product?

The cannabis excise stamp for the jurisdiction into which the cannabis product is being delivered must be affixed to the product.



The Cannabis Excise Stamp

The cannabis excise stamp shows to consumers, retailers and law enforcement, that cannabis duty and, where applicable, additional cannabis duty have been paid on the packaged cannabis products entered into the Canadian duty-paid market by a cannabis licensee. The stamp has various visible and covert security features.
