



Residency information for tax administration agreements

The Government of Canada and the Tł'chǫ Government have concluded a personal income tax administration agreement that provides that the Government of Canada will share the field of personal income tax with the Tł'chǫ Government. It also provides for the co-ordination of the *Tł'chǫ Income Tax Law* with the federal *Income Tax Act*.

All individuals, including non-Tł'chǫ citizens, who reside on Tł'chǫ lands or in the Tł'chǫ communities of Behchokǫ (Rae-Edzo), Whati (Lac La Martre), Gamèti (Rae Lakes), or Wekweèti (Snare Lake) are required to identify themselves by ticking "Yes" in the Residency information for tax administration agreements box on page 1 of the Northwest Territories 2008 *Income Tax and Benefit Return*.

Individuals, including Tł'chǫ citizens, who do not reside on Tł'chǫ lands or in a Tł'chǫ community should tick "No" in the Residency information for tax administration agreements box on page 1 of the Northwest Territories 2008 *Income Tax and Benefit Return*.

The Canada Revenue Agency will use this information to administer the personal income tax administration agreement with the Tł'chǫ Government.
