



Residency information for tax administration agreements

The Government of Canada and the Tłıchǵo Government have concluded a personal income tax administration agreement that provides that the Government of Canada will share the field of personal income tax with the Tłıchǵo Government. It also provides for the co-ordination of the *Tłıchǵo Income Tax Law* with the federal *Income Tax Act*.

All individuals, including non-Tłıchǵo citizens, who reside on Tłıchǵo lands or in the Tłıchǵo communities of Behchokǵ (Rae-Edzo), Whatì (Lac La Martre), Gamètì (Rae Lakes), or Wekweètì (Snare Lake) are required to identify themselves by ticking “Yes” in the Residency information for tax administration agreements box on page 1 of the Northwest Territories 2010 *Income Tax and Benefit Return*.

Individuals, including Tłıchǵo citizens, who do not reside on Tłıchǵo lands or in a Tłıchǵo community should tick “No” in the Residency information for tax administration agreements box on page 1 of the Northwest Territories 2010 *Income Tax and Benefit Return*.

The Canada Revenue Agency will use this information to administer the personal income tax administration agreement with the Tłıchǵo Government.
