## Notes:

- 1. All counts are rounded to the nearest ten and all amounts are rounded to the nearest thousand. The sum of the data may not add to the total, due to rounding.
- 2. Data are from (re)assessed income tax and benefit returns as of June 10, 2021 and are subject to change as more returns are (re)assessed. Amounts presented differ from those presented in the Greenhouse Gas Pollution Pricing Act annual report to Parliament for 2019, which was tabled in December 2020, because of differences in the cut-off date for the data extractions.
- 3. Amounts are as calculated on Schedule 14 Climate Action Incentive and reported on line 449.
- 4. CAI payments for the April 2019-March 2020 fuel charge year (which correspond to the fuel charge applying at a carbon price of \$20 per tonne) were largely claimed during the Spring of 2019, when most individuals filed their 2018 income tax returns. As a result, CAI payments for the 2019-20 fuel charge year are associated with, and presented as part of, 2018 taxation year assessments (and so on, for future years).
- 5. The fuel charge no longer applies in New Brunswick, as of April 1, 2020.
