1. All counts are rounded to the nearest ten and all amounts are rounded to the nearest thousand. The sum of the data may not add to the total, due to rounding.
2. Data are from (re)assessed income tax and benefit returns as of June 10, 2021 and are subject to change as more returns are (re)assessed.
3. Amounts are as calculated on Schedule 14 - Climate Action Incentive and reported on line 45110.
4. CAI payments for the April 2020–March 2021 fuel charge year (which correspond to the fuel charge applying at a carbon price of \$30 per tonne) were largely claimed during the Spring of 2020, when most individuals filed their 2019 income tax returns. As a result, CAI payments for the 2020–21 fuel charge year are associated with, and presented as part of, 2019 taxation year assessments (and so on, for future years).
5. The fuel charge applies in Alberta, effective January 1, 2020. The 2020 Climate Action Incentive payment claimed by eligible Albertans reflects fuel charge proceeds generated over a 15-month period. This consists of three months (January–March 2020) with a carbon price of \$20, plus 12 months (April 2020–March 2021) with a carbon price of \$30.
