



2023 Ontario energy and property tax credit (OEPTC) - Calculation sheet for married or common-law individuals who have or do not have children

Use this calculation if you had a spouse or a common-law partner and both of you were **under the age of 64** on December 31, 2022. This calculation sheet applies whether you have children or not.

Note

If one of you was **64 years of age or older** on December 31, 2022, then you should use the calculation sheet called Calculation sheet for married or common-law seniors who have or do not have children.

If your annual OEPTC amount plus, if applicable, your annual Ontario sales tax credit and Northern Ontario energy credit is:

- \$2.00 or less, no payment will be issued.
- from \$2.01 to \$10.00, you will receive one payment of \$10.00.
- \$360.00 or less, you will receive it in one payment instead of monthly.

The first monthly 2023 Ontario trillium benefit payment, which includes any OEPTC entitlement, will be issued on July 10, 2023.

However, if you made a choice on your 2022 return to [wait to receive](#) your 2023 OTB entitlement, it will be issued on June 10, 2024.
