5. Province/Territory is determined by the business address of the applicant, and may not fully reflect where the economic activity took place in Canada.
6. As applicants may submit a separate CERS claim for each period, the total number of properties for all periods can result in double counting if summing all periods together. As a result, the overall total for the number of properties is not displayed.
7. Industry sectors are derived using the North American Industrial Classification System codes assigned by Statistics Canada. 'Not Assigned' indicates that the applicant does not have a Statistics Canada assigned NAICS code.
8. Total Canada Emergency Rent Subsidy (Line 320) is the sum of Line 300 (Canada Emergency Rent Subsidy) and Line 310 (Lockdown Support).
9. A hyphen [-] indicates that the information has been suppressed for confidentiality purposes. Suppressed information also includes valid zeros.
