- Data are subject to change as claims are received, reviewed and adjusted.
- As CEWS claims can be retroactively submitted for any claim period that is open for application data for open periods are not yet complete. While older periods are no longer open for application data for all claim periods are subject to change.
- These data are compiled for CEWS claims that have been approved. CEWS applications currently under assessment or reassessment are excluded pending approval.
