- As employers may submit a separate CEWS claim for each period, the total number of employees for all periods can result in double counting if summing all periods together. As a result, the totals for employee and average per employee are not displayed. The total number of applications does not represent the number of unique employers.
- All counts are rounded to the nearest ten. Approved CEWS amounts are rounded to the nearest thousand. Average amounts are rounded to the nearest dollar.
- The sum of the data may not add to the total due to rounding.
- Number of employees are as reported on Line A and Line AA of the CEWS application. For periods 5 and subsequent, Line A is the number of eligible active employees. Line AA is only applicable from Period 5 onward and is represented by “-” (not applicable) for periods 1 through 4.
