announcement will be made



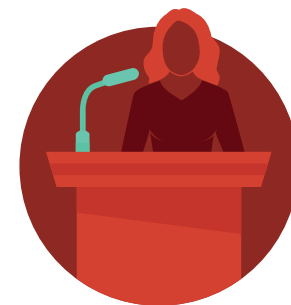
