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Operation HONOUR: Victim Support Study

On behalf of the CAF Strategic Response Team on Sexual Misconduct, Director General Military Personnel Research and Analysis (DGMPRA) is conducting a research study to examine the experiences of CAF members who have sought and/or received support after being affected by sexual harassment or violence.
