- k. Skinners Pond, Prince Edward Island Site B2, 46.96668° N, 64.12606° W (NAD83)
- I. West Point, Prince Edward Island, at approximately, 46.62017° N, 64.37050° W (NAD83)
- 9. Total quantity to be disposed of:
 - h. Skinners Pond Site B1: not to exceed 500 cubic metres, place measure
- i. Skinners Pond Site B2: not to exceed 500 cubic metres, place measure
- j. West Point: not to exceed 10 000 cubic metres, place measure
