Notice is hereby given that the Minister of the Environment, pursuant to subsection 129(3) of the *Canadian Environmental Protection Act, 1999* (CEPA), is varying the conditions of disposal at sea permit no. ATL-00128-1 as outlined below. The varied condition is published in the Canadian Environmental Protection Act Registry on Tuesday, March 2, 2021.

13.3. The permittee must submit a written report to the minister, as represented by the regional director of the Environmental Protection Operations Directorate, Atlantic Region, care of Christa Skinner, as identified in paragraph 13.1 a, within 30 days after the expiry of the permit. This report must provide the location of the loading and disposal sites used, the total number of hours of night dredging conducted at each loading site, the quantity of matter disposed of at the disposal sites and the dates on which disposal activities occurred.
