Canadian Environmental Protection Act, 1999

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of the Environment, pursuant to subsection 129(3) of the *Canadian Environmental Protection Act, 1999* (CEPA), is varying conditions of disposal at sea permit no. ATL-00329-1 as outlined below. The varied conditions are published in the Canadian Environmental Protection Act Registry on Tuesday, April 25, 2023.

10. Total quantity to be disposed of:

- g. West Point, Site B (CA-AT-D205): not to exceed 2 000 cubic metres, place measure
- h. West Point, Site C (CA-AT-D206): not to exceed 13 000 cubic metres, place measure

13. Reporting and notification:

13.1. The permittee must provide the following information, in writing, no later than 48 hours before loading and disposal activities commence and no sooner than 7 days before loading and disposal activities commence: name or number of ships, equipment, platforms or structures to be used to carry out the loading and/or disposal, name of the contractor, including corporate and on-site contact information; measures to estimate quantities of dredged material disposed at each disposal site and expected period of loading and disposal activities.
