

Compliance Unit Trading System (CUTS)

Annual report form for permit holders

If you have a permit under the Compliance Unit Trading System (CUTS) to manufacture or import products above the concentrations limits set out in Schedule 1, **you must submit an annual report no later than March 1 of each year** to Environment and Climate Change Canada (ECCC).

How to report:

Use this annual report form for each product permit under the CUTS. You must show how you have compensated for your excess quantity of volatile organic compounds (VOCs) and confirm whether you intend to continue manufacturing or importing your product under the approved permit. If you do not submit an annual report by March 1, then your permit will be revoked. Refer to sections 7 to 14 of the regulations to ensure all necessary information is provided and that you understand your responsibilities as a permit holder.

Timelines:

You must submit an annual report by March 1 of each year for the preceding calendar year for each valid permit you hold. For example, if you hold a valid permit in 2027, you would need to submit a report for the 2027 calendar year by March 1, 2028.

ECCC will provide you with a confirmation that you have balanced your compliance units and the number of compliance units that are available within 60 days after you submit your annual report. Compliance units whose availability is confirmed are valid for two years beginning on January 1 of the year following the calendar year in which they are generated.

Confidentiality:

Under section 313 of the Canadian Environmental Protection Act, all persons submitting information to the Minister are entitled to submit a written request that specific information be treated as confidential. Persons submitting such a request should also include the reasons for that request. Under each section of this application, you may request information be treated as confidential. You have been given space to provide your explanation. If you need more space, please attach added documents.
