


CERTIFICATION FORM - INTERPRETATION OF PERSON

Where a corporation has provided information to the New Substances program under the *New Substances Notification Regulations (Chemicals and Polymers)* or the *New Substances Notification Regulations (Organisms)* here after referred to as the Regulations, concerning a new substance, and where rights or privileges in relation to a substance have been transferred by the corporation (the original corporation) to another corporation, the New Substances program will consider the corporation to which the rights or privileges have been transferred (the successor corporation) as the person who has provided the information under subsection 81(1) or subsection 106(1) of *Canadian Environmental Protection Act, 1999* and the Regulations.
