TOPIC	COMMENT	RESPONSE
Persistence and Bioaccumulation	Even though components of these substances meet the persistence and bioaccumulation criteria, they are at worst marginally persistent or bioaccumulative.	The persistence and bioaccumulation properties of substance components are used in a weight of evidence approach for determining risk.
Risk Assessment Conclusion	Although the conclusions of the Assessment Reports are based on conservative and stringent scientific assumptions, they are supported as they are balanced and representative of the hazard information.	Noted.
Risk Management	The addition of aviation fuels to the <i>Environmental Emergency Regulations</i> is supported if they meet the criteria.	The addition of aviation fuels to the <i>Environmental Emergency Regulations</i> is being considered and will be subject to further consultations.
