



Tank Tip 10

If You Deliver Products

The **Storage Tank Systems for Petroleum Products and Allied Petroleum Products Regulations** set out requirements for the delivery of petroleum or allied petroleum products to regulated storage tank systems.

If you deliver such products to storage tank systems subject to these Regulations (see **Tank Tip 1** to determine to which systems the Regulations apply), you must:

immediately report to the system operator:

- any release that reaches the environment during the transfer
- any evidence observed of a leak or of any release

and

keep a record of the identification number issued by Environment and Climate Change Canada of the system (the letters EC followed by a dash and 8 digits, e.g. EC-00001234)

You are **prohibited from filling storage tank systems subject to the Regulations that do not have a visible identification number** issued by Environment and Climate Change Canada. If you fill such systems, you may be in violation of **section 29** of the Regulations and may be subject to enforcement measures as outlined in the Compliance and Enforcement Policy for the *Canadian Environmental Protection Act, 1999*.

Help Your Customers Comply

Share the following information with your customers! Owners of unidentified storage tank systems can easily identify them through the Federal Identification Registry for Storage Tank Systems (FIRSTS) at www.ec.gc.ca/rfiss-firsts/secureprotege/LoginEntree.aspx. FIRSTS generates an identification number as soon as the required information on the storage tank system is submitted, in accordance with **Schedule 2** of the Regulations. Owners who do not have Internet access or are unable to use FIRSTS can request the identification form by emailing registre-reservoir-tankregistry@ec.gc.ca or by calling **1-844-672-8038** to receive it by email or mail. **Tank Tip 3** has more information for your customers.
