





Are you eligible for the

Wage Earner Protection Program

The Government of Canada's **Wage Earner Protection Program (WEPP)** provides timely payment to employees who are owed wages when their employer goes bankrupt, enters receivership, or undergoes a qualifying insolvency proceeding.

What WEPP covers

- Wages, commissions, production bonuses, shift premiums, and gratuities reported by the employer, business expenses for travelling salespeople and, accrued vacation pay
- Termination and severance pay

▶ How much you could get

One-time payment equivalent to up to 7 weeks of Employment Insurance maximum insurable earnings. In 2026, the maximum payment is \$9,275.00 and is revised annually

Who can apply

To qualify, you must:

- have lost your job
- be owed wages from an insolvent employer and
- have earned wages within the eligibility period (6 months before insolvency)

How to apply

- 1. Submit a **proof of claim** to the trustee or receiver managing the insolvency
- 2. Apply online or in person at a Service Canada Centre
