
ESDC 2022-23 Supplementary Estimates (C) Overview

ESDC is requesting a total of \$1,478.6 million in additional authorities through the Supplementary Estimates (C), which would bring the total planned spending to \$176.6 billion.

Of the \$176.6 billion in planned spending for 2022-23, \$89.2 billion is reported in the Estimates, of which \$87.6 billion are statutory and voted transfer payment programs. Here are a few programs included in ESDC's Estimates to date:
