WHO IS A QUALIFIED PERSON?

A qualified person possesses the knowledge, training and experience to fulfill the competencies of the role(s) defined in the regulations below. This role may need to be fulfilled by more than one gualified person with different fields of expertise.

Asbestos exposure prevention and control specialists or industrial hygienists knowledgeable in asbestos and asbestos hazards are examples of persons qualified to conduct the hazard investigation and the risk assessment.

What a qualified person needs to know:

- The Canada Labour Code Part II and the Canada Occupational Health and Safety Regulations Part X Hazardous Substances, Division II
- Technical Guideline to Asbestos Exposure Management Programs*
