Re: Amendment of existing Levies Order SOR/2016-236

The Canadian Beef Cattle Research, Market Development and Promotion Agency is seeking the amendment of its existing Levies Order SOR/2016-236, to update the definitions for classes of cattle to align with production stages. The amendments will also move to a single levy rate mechanism, based on the seller's province of residence. The levy rates for Saskatchewan and Newfoundland & Labrador will be adjusted to \$5.25 and \$2.50, respectively.

We also propose amending the import levy payment terms to align them with accounting practices. Lastly, we propose several minor edits and table reordering to improve clarity and consistency.
