**Re: Federal Levies Orders Amendments – Changes to Provincial/Territorial Levy Amounts**

Dear Carole:

EFC is requesting that FPCC initiate the review process by FPCC's Levy Committee to obtain prior approval for an amendment to the Canadian Egg Marketing Agency's Levies Order. This request is in accordance with EFC's process to amend the Federal Levies Order upon notification of requested changes to provincial/territorial levy amounts.

Four (4) provincial commodity boards have provided EFC with notice of a change to their respective provincial levy amount. For each commodity board, the change is being implemented to adjust the current budget of each commodity board.

Drafting instructions reflecting the Levies Order amendment coming into force on the day on which it is registered will be provided to FPCC at the same time as the Department of Justice (DoJ). Official stamped copies of the Levies Order amending package will be forwarded to your office in accordance with DoJ's timeline to examine regulatory amendments.

The table on the following page summarizes the amendment to the Federal Levies Order.
