Cher Monsieur Smith,

Lors de sa réunion du 11 juin 2024, le Conseil des produits agricoles du Canada (le Conseil) a examiné les modifications proposées à l'*Ordonnance sur les redevances à payer pour la recherche, le développement des marchés et la promotion des bovins de boucherie*, tel que demandé dans les requêtes datées du 15 avril 2024, du 10 mai 2024 et du 13 mai 2024.

Après un examen approfondi des justifications fournies par l'Agence canadienne de prélèvement du bœuf (Agence) et suite à une analyse interne, les membres du Conseil ont convenu que la modification de la date d'expiration ainsi que les nouvelles définitions pour le veau étaient nécessaires à la mise en œuvre du plan de promotion et de recherche de l'Agence tel qu'énoncé dans la *Proclamation visant l'Office canadien de recherche, de développement des marchés et de promotion des bovins de boucherie*. Le Conseil félicite l'Agence d'avoir trouvé une solution faisant consensus sur les définitions des classes de veau qui faciliteront la perception des redevances pour cette catégorie de bétail.

The Canadian Beef Cattle Research, Market Development and Promotion Agency is seeking to amend its existing Levies Order SOR/2016-236 to establish and amend definitions related to classes of veal cattle originating in Ontario and Quebec and establish the levy amount for started calves and veal cattle originating in Quebec at \$5.50 and \$17.75 respectively.

Furthermore, the Agency is seeking the amendment of its existing Levies Order SOR/2016-236 to extend the date of cessation to June 30, 2025.

The extension of the Levies Order will fully fund the Agency's 2024/25 business plan, which was approved on March 6, 2024.

Re: Amendment of existing Levies Order SOR/2016-236

The Canadian Beef Cattle Research, Market Development and Promotion Agency is seeking the amendment of its existing Levies Order SOR/2016-236 to establish the levy amount for bob calves, milk-fed calves, and grain-fed calves originating in Ontario at \$7.50. These rates will align with provincial rates established by the Veal Farmers of Ontario to support the development of the veal sector. This increase will not impact the levy rate for beef cattle.

However, the Agency seeks to establish levy rates for feeder cattle, fed cattle, and cull cows at \$5.50 to ensure that the Levies Order applies to all cattle originating in Ontario.
