## Pesticides and Human Health

Before a pesticide can be sold or used in Canada, a thorough science-based risk assessment is done.





Health Canada scientists evaluate hundreds of studies on the potential human health effects and exposure routes a pesticide could take, including through diet, contact with skin and inhalation.

## Directions for use

and warnings on approved pesticide labels can include wearing gloves, only using the product in well-ventilated areas, and keeping pesticides out of reach of children and pets.





Before using a pesticide, always read the label and check for the registration number ensuring the product is authorized for use by Health Canada.
