

Lithium-ion battery fires in larger, more powerful rechargeable products can be severe and hard to extinguish.

Reduce your fire risk:

- Use the original battery and charger that came with your device.
- Contact the original manufacturer or product retailer if you need a replacement battery.
- Charge your battery away from exit doors in case of fire.
- Store and use your battery according to the manufacturer's instructions.
- Never modify, tamper with or build your own lithium-ion battery.
- Never use a damaged or modified battery. Dispose of batteries that are worn out or show signs of damage.
- Check with your municipality on how to safely dispose of your batteries.
