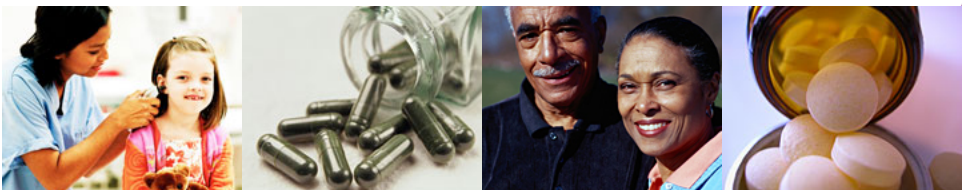


Summary

The application of this guidance will lead to reports that consistently address these needs.

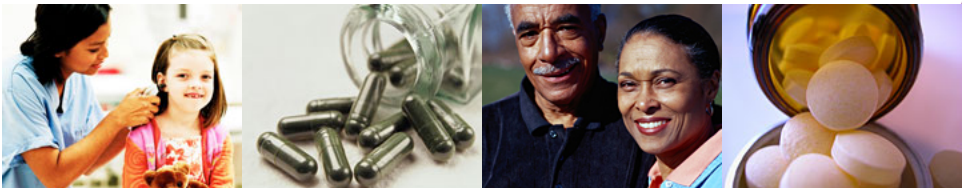


Summary

- positive reporting

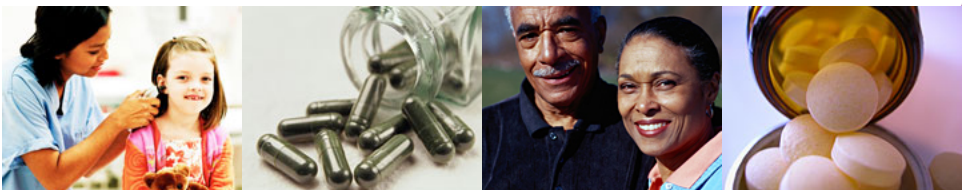


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
