- Find a school that's right for you and apply
- Apply for a study permit as soon as possible



- Work while you study



Help your spouse/partner work while you study

- Get a post-graduation work permit (PGWP)

With a PGWP, you can work for up to three years in Canada for almost any employer



- Get another type of work permit if you are not eligible for PGWP
- Explore other types of work permits you could be eligible for



Help your spouse/partner keep working while you work

- With Canadian educational credentials and work experience, you're a great candidate to apply to stay permanently
