






Permanent Resident Backlog Over Time



Higher immigration levels are not a solution







Total immigration backlog






Federal Skilled Worker (FSW) Backlog




Assumptions for Actual FSW Inventory, 2013-2015:

- FSW admission levels remain at approximately 55,000 per year if possible, and if not, levels are reallocated to other categories.
- FSW intake of 34,700 persons each year.

Parents and Grandparents (PGP) Backlog




Assumptions for Actual PGP Inventory, 2013-2015:


- PGP admission levels remain at approximately 25,000 per year.

Business Class Backlog




Assumptions for Actual Business Inventory, 2013-2015:


- Business admission levels remain at approximately 6,000 per year.

Live-in Caregiver Program (LCP) Backlog




Assumptions for Actual LCP Inventory, 2013-2015:


- LCP admission levels remain at approximately 9,000 per year.




Humanitarian and Compassionate (H&C) Backlog




Backlog Reduction Action Taken: In 2011, CIC created four Backlog Reduction Offices to reduce the backlog of pre-removal risk assessment (PRRA) applications and applications for permanent residence based on humanitarian and compassionate considerations (H&C). Since refugee reform legislation was passed in June 2012, there has been a significant decrease in both intake for PRRA and H&C applications. The backlog is projected to be at zero later in 2015 at the current rate.
