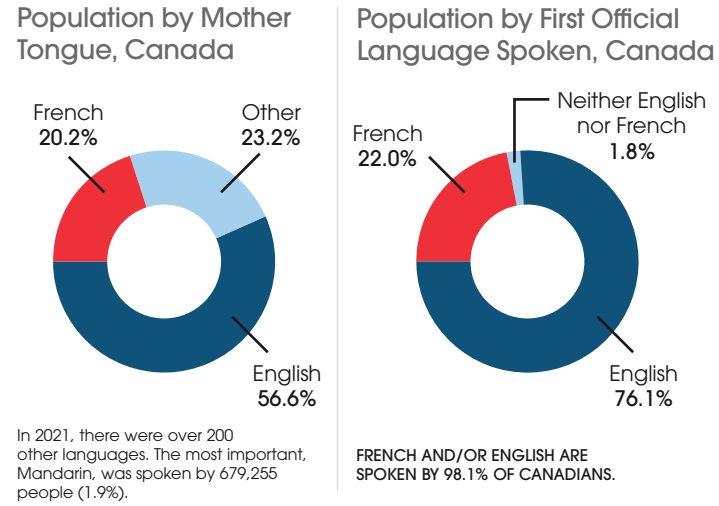
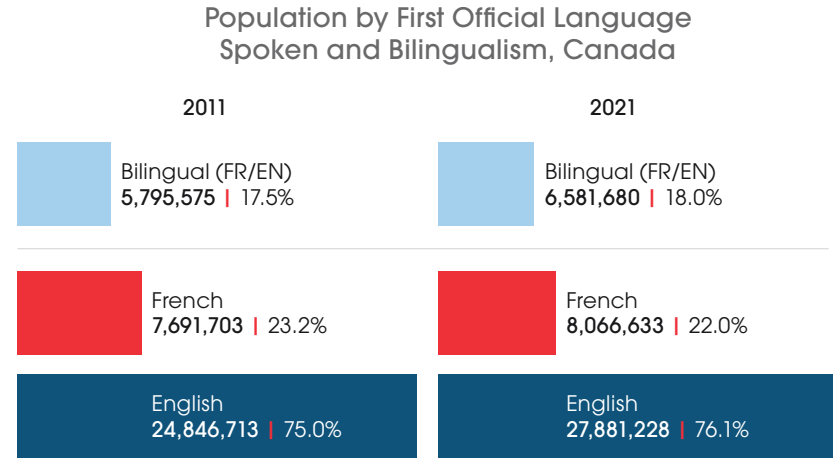

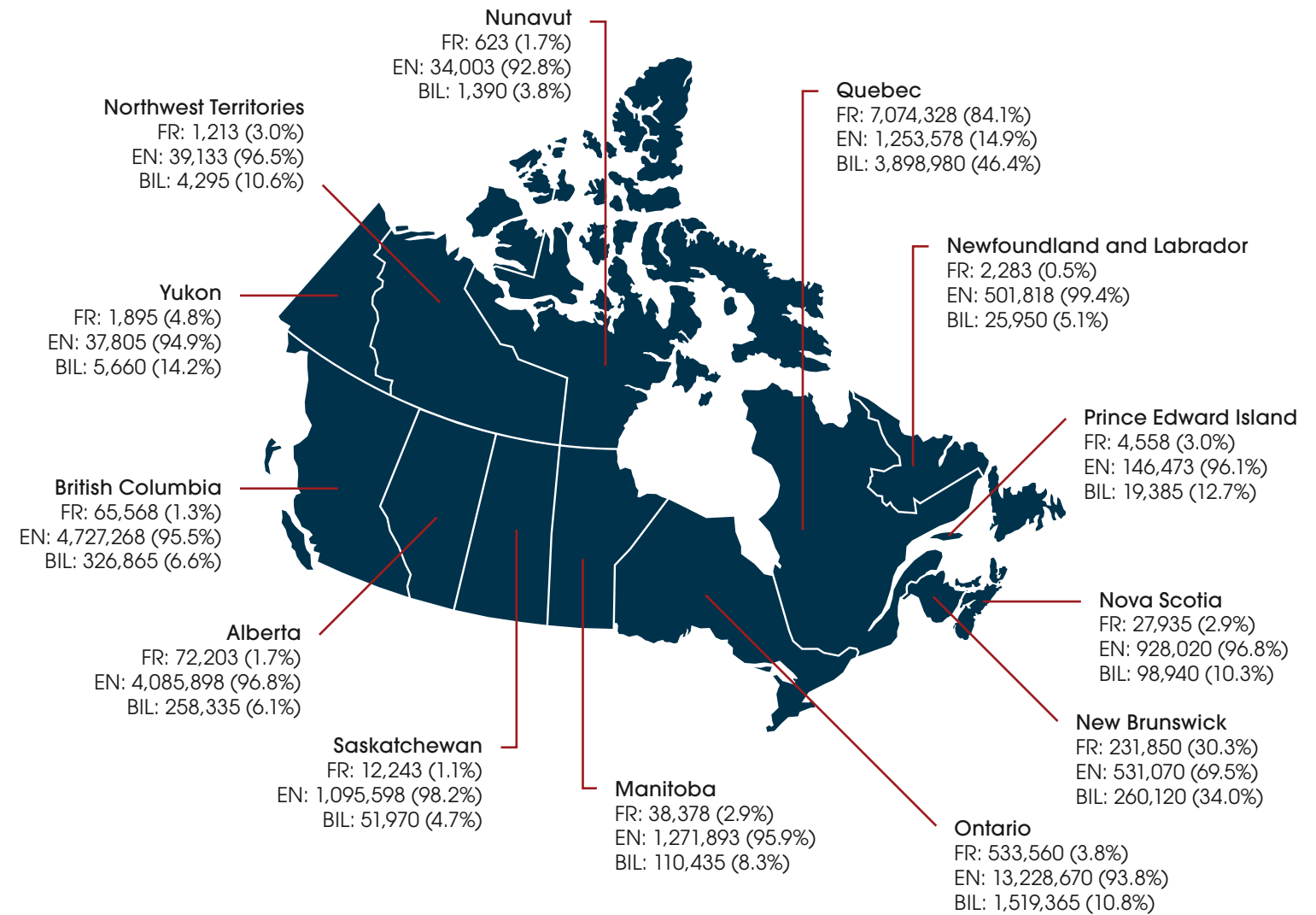

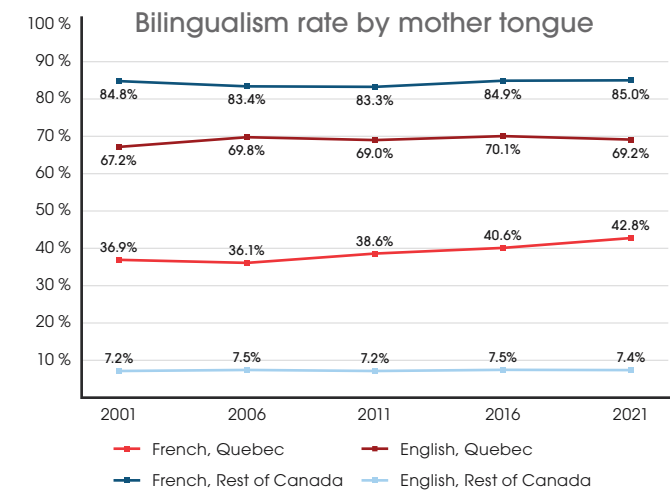


THE DEMOGRAPHIC PICTURE VARIES BY PROVINCE OR TERRITORY

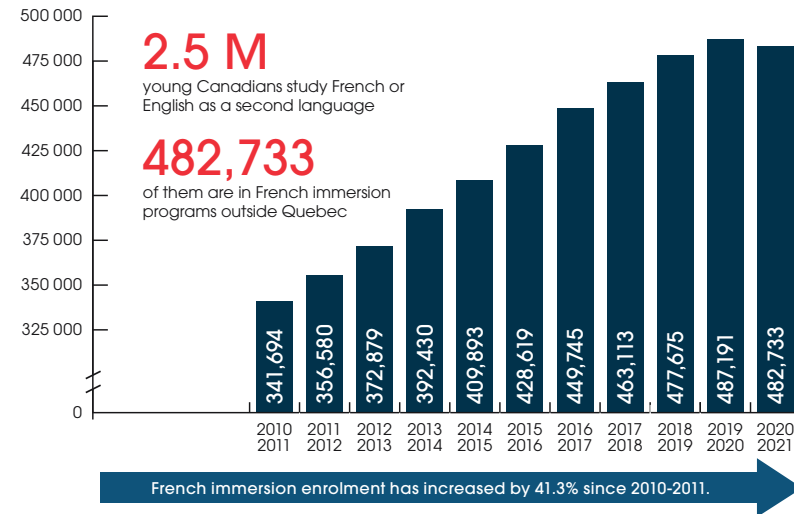
Population by First Official Language Spoken and Bilingualism, Provinces and Territories



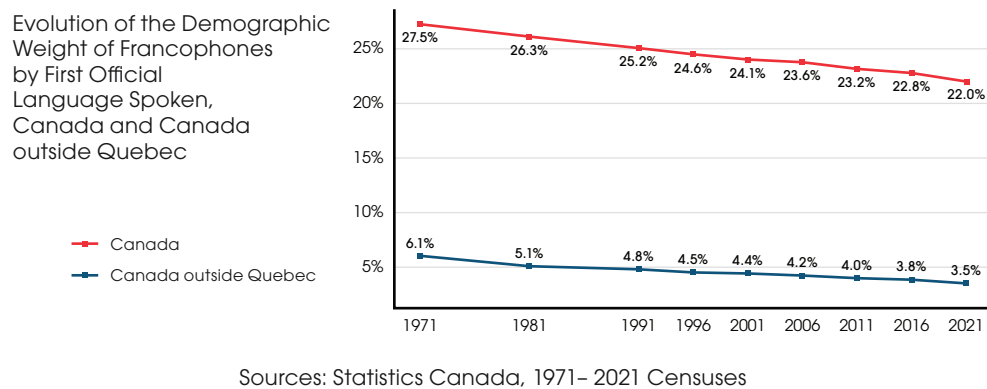
BILINGUALISM VARIES CONSIDERABLY BY GROUP



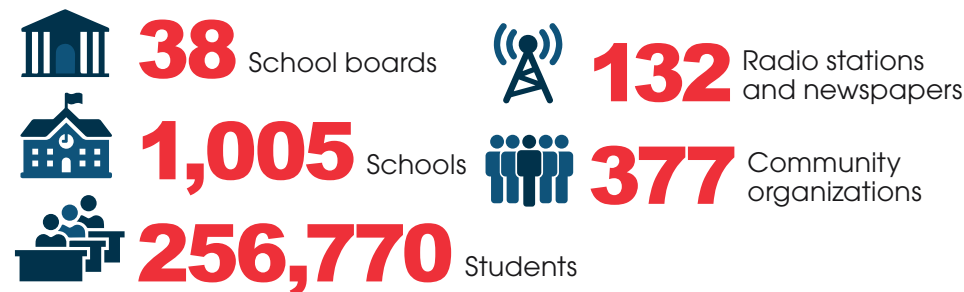
MORE AND MORE YOUNG PEOPLE STUDY THEIR SECOND LANGUAGE
