**Definitions:**

Canadian materials refers only to steel, wood products, and aluminum that are produced and manufactured in Canada. Produced in Canada means materials that have undergone primary manufacturing and fabrication in Canada. Further details are available [here](#).

Canadian content refers to Canadian value-added in goods, services or labour, including both goods and services.

- For services: Canadian content reflects work performed by people based in Canada.
- For goods: Canadian content reflects value added in Canada, such as assembly, customization, installation, integration, training, commissioning, or support carried out in Canada.
