Entering Canada by AIR during COVID-19

Travellers entering Canada must follow the rules set out by the Emergency Orders under the Quarantine Act to help reduce the spread of COVID-19 and its variants. Failure to comply with any requirements or providing false information may result in fines, penalties or imprisonment. If you develop symptoms at any time, isolate yourself from others and contact local public health.

Before Departure

Plan your quarantine.



Pre-book your governmentauthorized hotel for 3 nights.





molecular test within 72 hours before your scheduled flight. Register for your arrival test in advance to save time at the airport.





Use ArriveCAN to enter your information.

Have your ArriveCAN receipt and test result ready to show when boarding.

Upon Arrival to Canada





Collect a test kit for use on Day 10 of your quarantine.*

Complete a COVID-19 molecular test.



Provide required information and documents. Answer all eligibility and health screening questions.

If you have symptoms or an unsuitable quarantine plan, you will be directed to a designated quarantine facility.

Your quarantine

Go to your pre-booked hotel. Create an account with Switch Health for your Day 10 test.*



If your arrival test is negative:

Check out of the hotel and go directly to your place of quarantine.

Complete and ship the Day 10 test kit according to the instructions.

Relocate to a designated quarantine facility or other suitable location as directed.

Your 14-day quarantine period begins again from the time you took your positive test.



Use ArriveCAN or call 1-833-641-0343 to check-in the day after you enter Canada and to report symptoms daily.

You will be contacted by **Government of** Canada and provincial /territorial officials.

If positive:
