



HEPATITIS C in CANADA 2019 Surveillance Data

11,441 total number of hepatitis C cases reported in 2019, for a rate of 30.4 per 100,000 people






Total hepatitis C rates are **highest** among males and females 25 - 39 year old

of total hepatitis C cases are among males








Decrease in national total hepatitis C rates since 2018
