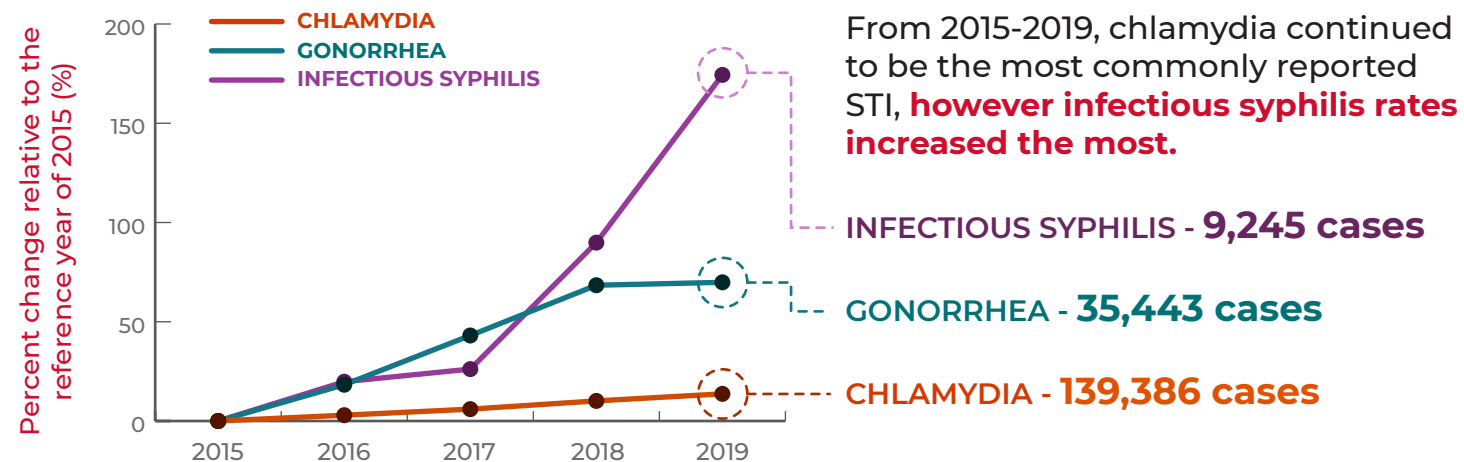
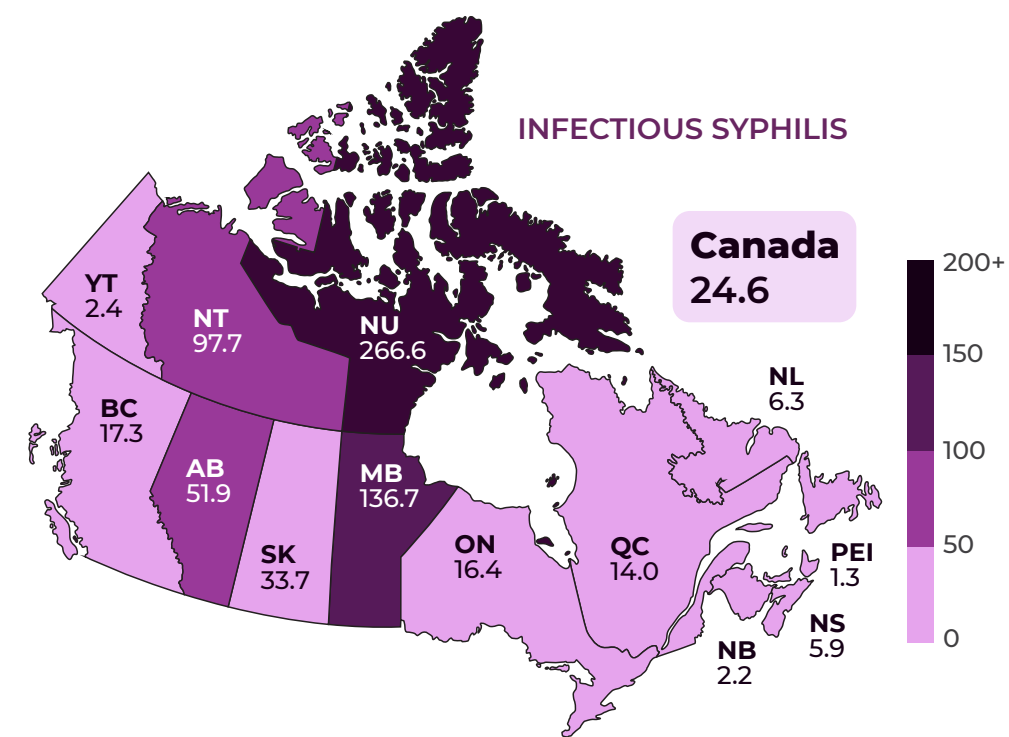
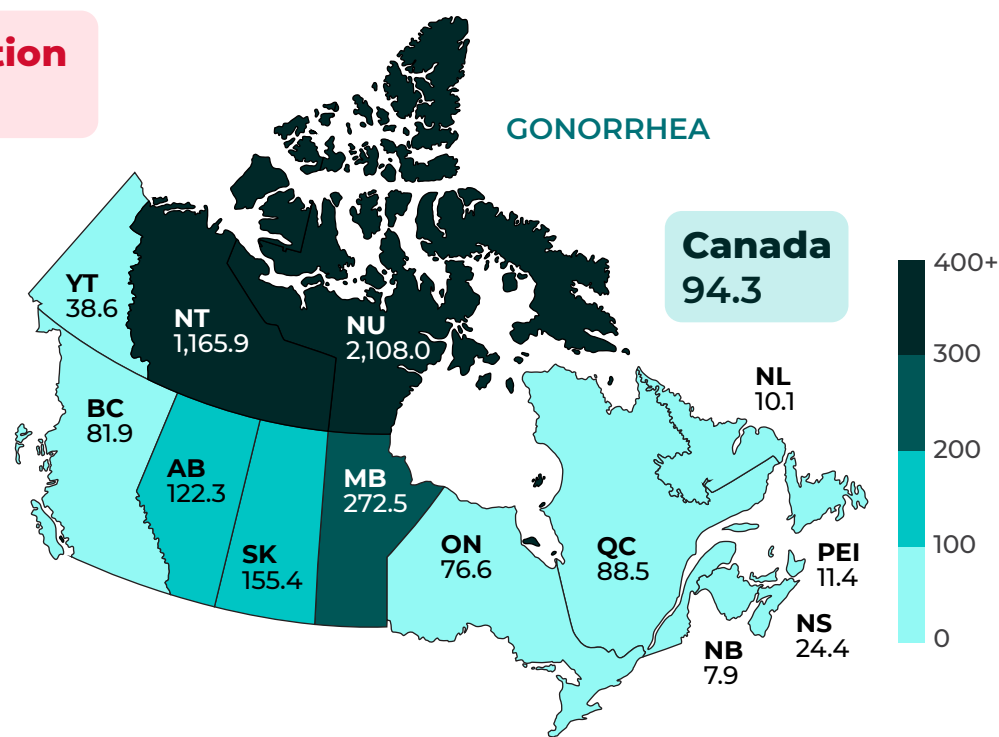
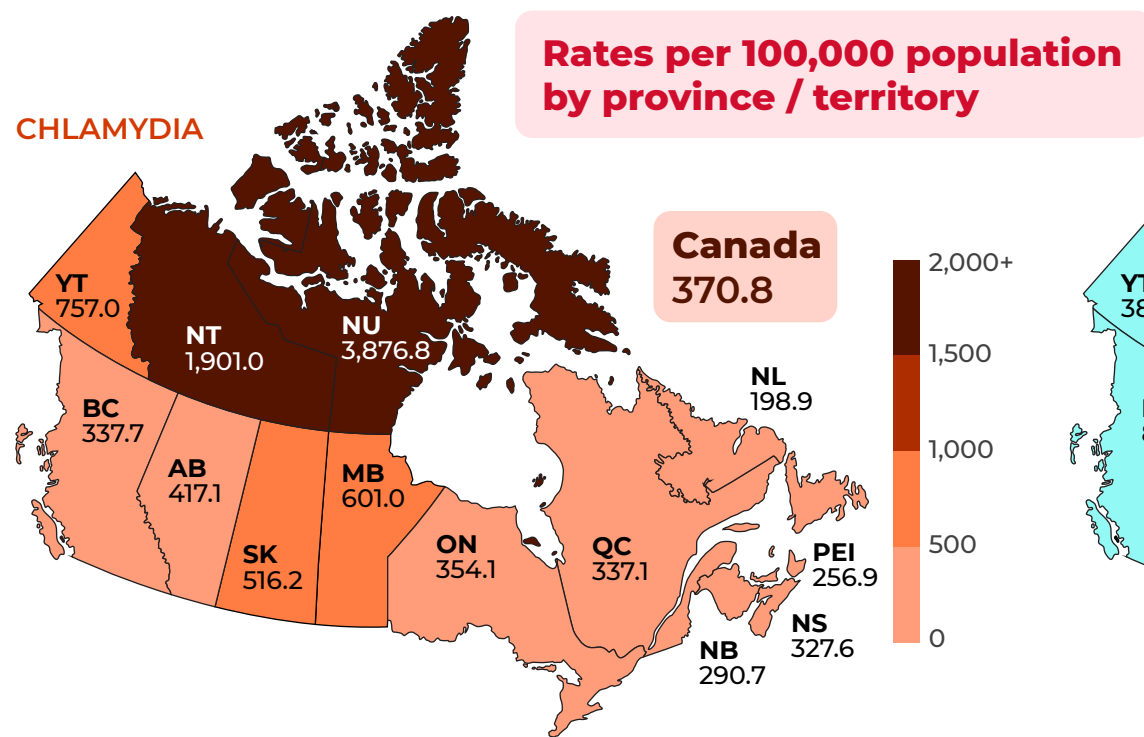
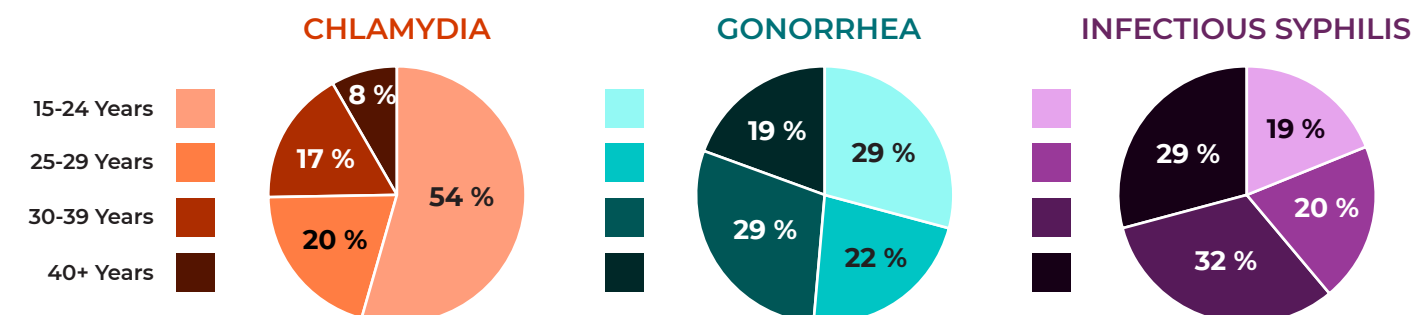


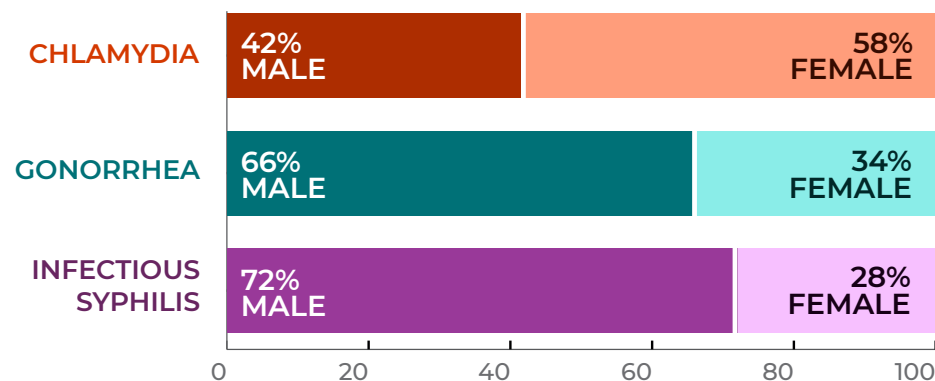
# Chlamydia, Gonorrhoea & Infectious Syphilis\* in Canada, 2019†



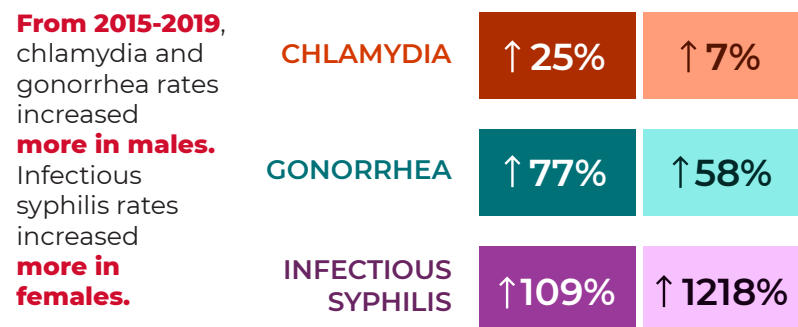
In 2019, 74% of chlamydia cases, 51% of gonorrhoea cases and 39% of infectious syphilis cases were among people **less than 30 years of age**
