Public Services and Procurement Canada (PSPC) recently repaired and restored the 77-year-old National War Memorial. The Memorial is the site of Canada's national Remembrance Day ceremony each year. Here is a glimpse of how PSPC restored the cenotaph.



• WHAT DID WE DO? •

- Demolished, removed and replaced the existing concrete slab
- Introduced a waterproofing membrane and ensured the concrete slab slopes to the drains
 - Replaced and repaired damaged pavers
 - Cleaned and repaired the cenotaph masonry
- Cleaned all the bronze figures and re-waxed them with a new protective coating
